As you can see the staff enjoyed it too!

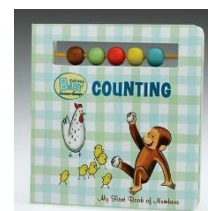

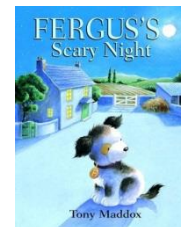
Story and Rhyme of the Month
